Oak Ridge Boys Basketball Program Class Expectations

ATHLETE EXPECTATIONS AGREEMENT

The basic principle of our expectations under which we will always operate is:

To conduct yourself in such a manner that you bring credit to YOUR self, family, teammates, Oak Ridge Boys Basketball program, and Oak Ridge High School. As members of this program, you will not engage in any activity that can be viewed as inappropriate to any of these previously listed groups. Our R.I.S.E. (Respect, Integrity, Service, and Education) values are expected to be lived by each member of our program to create successful leaders in our community and of the future

1. WE will RESPECT our: Selves, Program, School, Community, and Families

Social/School:

- a. Correct class, cafeteria, and hallway representation is expected. Arguing will not be tolerated
- b. Use Social Media positively. What you Post, Like, Share, and Retweet will be viewed as your thoughts and addressed accordingly
- c. Bullying and hazing are not permitted and will result in a conference with parent
- d. Offensive language and Sagging (Pants below waist exposing under garments) will be addressed and redirected
- e. Adhere to school dress code rules at all times, even when off-campus if representing ORHS

Drugs/Alcohol/Unlawful behavior (ex: stealing, police, probation, etc.): Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, e-cigarettes, and other substances have no place in athletics

- a. Conference w/ Head Coach, Athletic Director and/or Principal, and a determination of appropriate punishment will be determined based on severity

2. WE will be present, on time, and participating in class:

***Medical issues are to be reported immediately to the training room staff, if not seen by a physician. Only Doctor or Trainer notes count as excused. Training room opens daily at 6:30 AM. Be there if injured**

Participation/Dressing Out:

- A. Players will be issued practice uniforms.
- B. Students are expected to be dressed out in practice gear daily
- C. Stealing/Borrowing others' clothes or things without their consent will not be tolerated
- D. Non-excused absences will result in decreased or no playing time in the following contest

3. WE will value learning and education

Grades: Grades at 3 weeks below 3 grade points (B) will be ran for. Failed or low exam scores are suggested to be discussed with the teacher, then corrected or made up.

******Coaches make final decisions on if students will become a part of the team. Failure to live up these standards will result in disciplinary actions and/or removal from period and/or team**

Practices: Players are expected to be at every practice throughout the season. Normal practice days will be Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Varsity will practice on Saturdays throughout the season. Times are 2:45-3:45 (Freshman and JV). 3:30-5:00 for Varsity. Be aware that times and days are subject to change with notification.

Road Games/Tournaments:

- a. Players are required to wear their game day spirit shirt for all games (except tournaments).
- b. Pre-game meals (Chick-Fil-A) are available for purchase for away games. The program will only provide meals for tournament days where 2 games are played.
- c. All players are required to travel on the team bus to games.
- d. In an effort to support each and build program support, players will be asked to stay for the game following their games throughout the season (9 Blue dismissed after JV Blue, JV Red dismissed after 9 Red).
- e. Cell phone use will be allowed for music or emergency contact with parents only during travel. Irresponsible use will result in them not being permitted.

Class Tardies and Referrals: Students are given 8 minutes to get to class during the school day. Each tardy will result in 8 sideline touches to be completed in 30 seconds. The 7th tardy in a year will result in 16 sideline touches to be completed in 1 minute. Referrals will result in 16s as well.

Chain of Command: If you have an issue at any time during the season, please reach out to the immediate coach of your son's team. If you feel your issue is not considered or handled, then reach out to Coach Cloudy. Finally, if things cannot be handled within our sport we will take it to the athletic coordinator and/or principal. Playing time is not an issue that will be considered.
